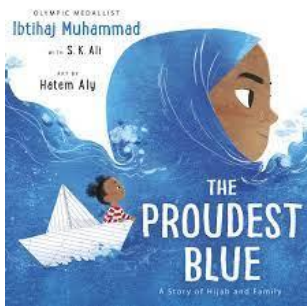


YEAR 2 ♥ READING

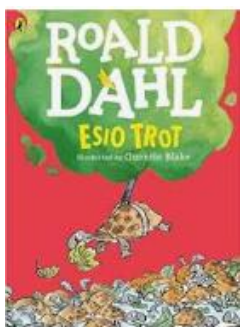

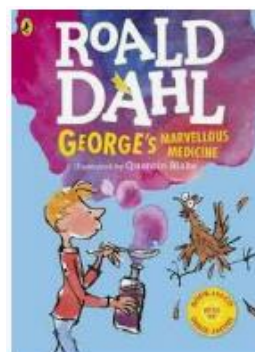

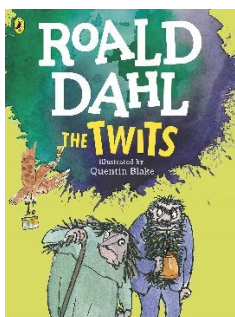
A fantastic story full of drama and adventure. Will Mr Fox outsmart the farmers?
