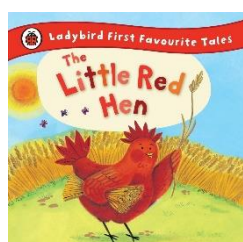


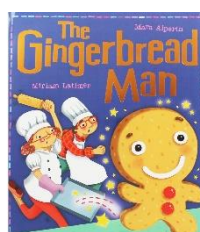
REC READING

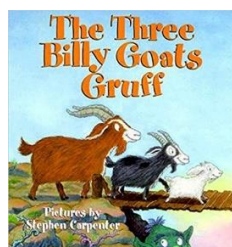
Autumn 1

The Little Red Hen is a traditional tale about a hen who asks for help making bread and isn't helped by her friends. Will she share her bread at the end?



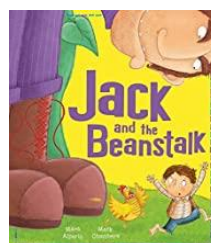
Autumn 2

The Gingerbread Man is a firm favourite. This book has all the elements required for an exciting tale with drama, excitement but doesn't have the happily ever after ending.



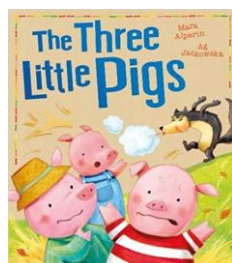
Spring 1
