### **English**

Using Michael Morpurgo's
Kensuke's Kingdom, the children
will write a diary entry based on
Michael's experience. The
children will also look at the high
level vocabulary used in the text
and will begin to use some of
that vocabulary in their work.

The children will also use the text as the basis for a balanced argument about taking time out of school.

#### **Mathematics**

Children will be learning about 2D and 3D shapes including regular and irregular polygons.

Position and direction focusing on reflection and translation with coordinates.

Adding and subtracting decimal numbers and decimal sequences.

Comparing, ordering and using negative numbers.

## Geography

Children will learn about the countries of Europe. They will then look in more detail at some of the contrasting areas of eastern Europe, finding out about the landscape, climate and locations in each area. Children will bring together their learning about one area of eastern Europe and create information booklets to share what they have found out.

## Art

The children will study the artist Hokusai and create their own version of 'The Great Wave'.

#### Science

The life cycle of a human being. They will investigate the development of babies and compare the gestation period of humans and other animals. They will learn about the changes experienced during puberty and why these occur.
