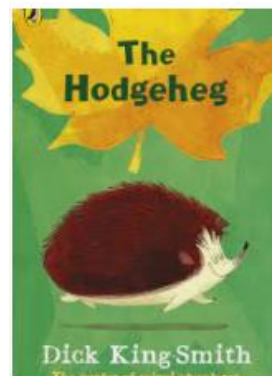


YEAR 3 ❤️ READING

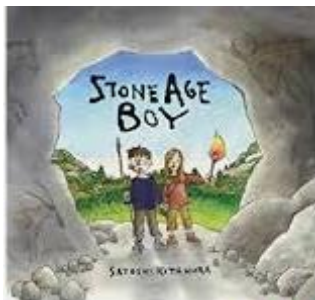

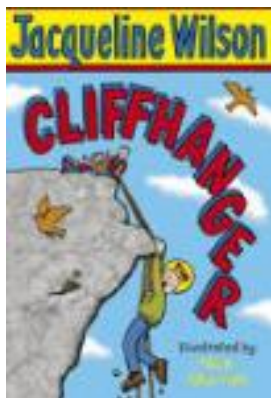

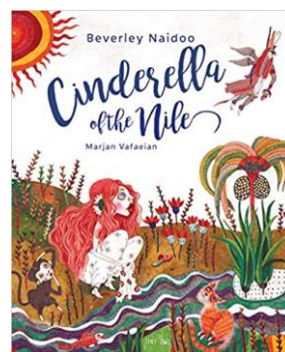
Linked to Year 3's topic, Stone Age to Iron Age, they read Stone Age Boy which is a story about a boy who stumbles into the stone age!
