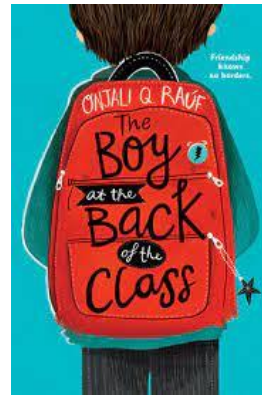


# YEAR 6 ♥ READING

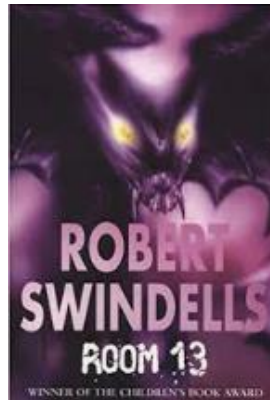
Linked to our World War 2 topic in Autumn 1, we read Michael Morpurgo's story about two evacuees who make a discovery on the moors.



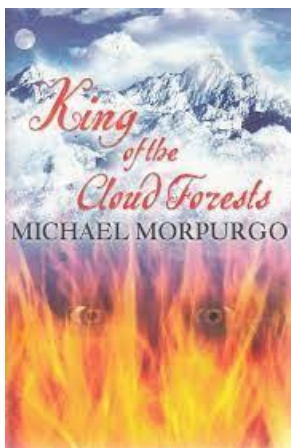
Spanning Autumn 1 and 2, we read *The Boy at the Back of the Class* which is a story showing a child's perspective on the refugee crisis. The story highlights friendship and kindness.



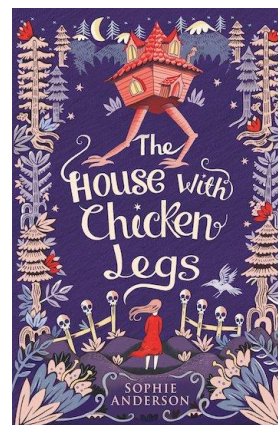
During Autumn 2, we read the Charles Dickens classic, *A Christmas Carol*. A great story to read in the run up to Christmas.



As we start to look at writing suspense in the spring term, we read *Room 13* which is a story about a group of children who stay at a spooky guest house on Whitby's West Cliff.



Written by Michael Morpurgo, *King of the Cloud Forests* is a story about a boy and his uncle escaping from China and embarking on a perilous journey across the Himalayas.



*The House with Chicken Legs* by Sophie Anderson is a reimagining of the Russian fairy tale *Baba Yaga*. In this story, Marinka dreams of a normal life where her house remains in one place. However, her house has chicken legs and will move!
