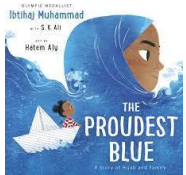
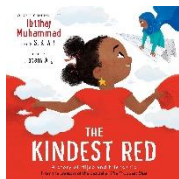


YEAR 2 READING

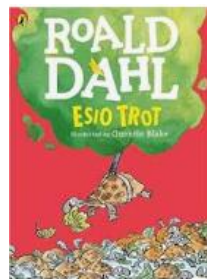


It's Faizah's older sister's first day of wearing her hijab. Not everyone sees it as beautiful. Will Faizah find new ways to be strong?

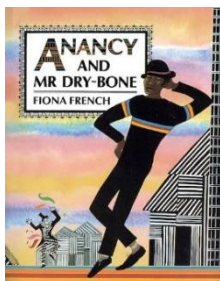
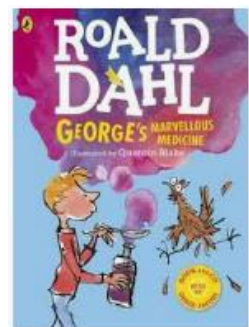


Faizah imagines a world where everyone is kind and tries to create that at school.

A story that has the children desperate to hear more. What will George put into the medicine and what will happen to poor, old grandma?

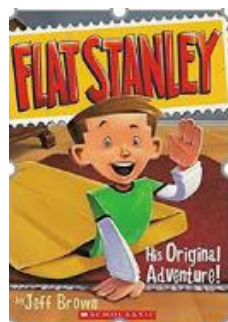

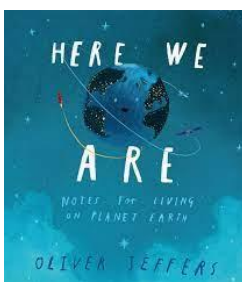
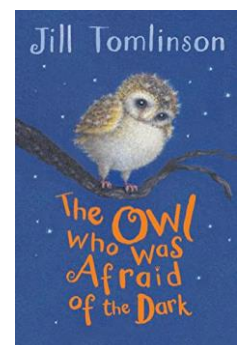
