English

Starting with Macbeth, children begin with a character analysis and consider how the key characters change as the story evolves. They use this to write a diary entry as Macbeth with an emphasis on 'show not tell' to describe characters' actions.

Topic

Children learn about what life was like in Tudor England. They learn about crime and punishment and how and why punishments and crimes have changed by comparing them with modern Britain. Children also learn about Henry VIII's impact on religion and the reasons why he made changes, look at different types of Christianity.
